Internationally renowned Italian market coming to historic West Palm Beach venue

Slated to open in fall 2025, the world-renowned Italian food hall Eataly is coming to CityPlace in downtown West Palm Beach.

Featuring a huge variety of imported Italian goods, quick service counters and more, Eataly will join the shopping and dining destination in approximately one year and take its place pretty much center stage at the complex in the Harriet Himmel building.

The historic structure in the heart of CityPlace, which was built in 1926 and originally a church, is currently undergoing renovations in preparation for Eataly's arrival.

"The historic Harriet Himmel building is an ideal location for Eataly's Italian market and restaurant concept, which will honor the rich heritage of CityPlace's long-standing community center, while also introducing a new, must-visit gastronomic destination for locals and visitors alike." says Gopal Rajegowda, executive vice president, Related Ross.

Started in 2002, Eataly's core concept from the start has been to gather under one roof high-quality food at sustainable and reasonable prices for all, celebrate Italian biodiversity and create an informal, natural, and simple place to eat, shop, and learn.

"We're incredibly excited to enter the South Florida market and look forward to bringing the Italian art of living to the West Palm Beach community at CityPlace," said Tommaso Brusò, CEO of Eataly North America. "As a true lifestyle destination with an impressive mix of retail,

art, design, and cuisine, CityPlace couldn't have been a better match for our incoming flagship store."

A symbol of Italian culinary artistry, Eataly features products including caviar, wine, truffles, pastas, olive oil, sweet treats and more, it also offers cooking classes teaching guests how to make fresh pasta, pizza, cannoli, biscotti and more along with wine pairing and tasting classes.

There are currently over 50 Eataly locations around the world with outlets in London, Paris, Munich, Stockholm, San Paolo, Japan, Korea and Istanbul.

In the United States there are Eataly stores in Chicago, Boston, Los Angeles, Las Vegas, Dallas, San Jose and three in New York City.

In addition to CityPlace in West Palm Beach, Eataly will open another store in South Florida in Aventura. That location is slated to open in spring 2025.
